Charlie Wilson is in the process of setting up all over the United State. The phone system works from beaming your cell phone off "current location cell tower" no matter where you are to let you know where the local Republican Club is located and contact information for that specific club. So you are always a phone call away from a meeting.

It is also a benefit for the clubs in that they get transferee's, people traveling and more. The goals and benefits for the 833-GOP-2018 program are currently in all 67 Counties in Florida which is the project Mrs. White has been working on since December. Helps connect new people with their local party. Builds grassroots support from the local not state level. Helps to centralize the hub for Republican activity.

The system is flexible to change destination numbers (contact person) any time but consistent for the public so as officers and contacts change it is simple to swap to a new person. FFRW leading the way want REC to work with them. Goal is 1,000 new REC members before the election. The number does not affect the local number just additional calls from easy to remember number.

She was a resident of Apopka who was well known for her community involvement and outstanding dedication. She was also a founding, active member of NORWF. The scholarship is awarded every year for an amount of \$1,000.

This scholarship will be awarded to any high school senior, full time college undergraduate or graduate student who is registered in or attending an accredited college and is a registered Republican who lives in Orange county . He or she must have demonstrated leadership on campus, place of worship or in the community. Applicants must have participated in the campaign process, either as a candidate in an organization at school or in the community or by helping with a campaign.
