

- **VOTE** in the NFRW Republican Presidential Straw Poll (every four years);
- **RECOGNIZE** distinguished leadership and service within the NFRW;
- **NETWORK** with women from across the country;
- **COMMEMORATE** milestones, anniversaries and other important events;
- **PLAN** the future of the Federation and **CONDUCT** Federation business;
- and so much more.

NEXT UP: The NFRW's 43rd Biennial Convention is September 25-28, 2025, in Orlando, Florida.

The following are the voting delegates:


NFRW Bylaws Article IX, Section 3(A)(3)(4)(5):

The voting body of the Biennial Convention shall be:

1. one delegate from each club,
2. five delegates-at-large from each state federation, and one additional delegate-at-large for each 500 members or major fraction thereof in the state federation based on the payment to the NFRW of the current year's dues and postmarked ninety days prior to the convention,
3. presidents of state federations,
4. voting members of the NFRW Executive Committee, chairmen of NFRW standing committees, or in the absence of a chairman, the vice chairman of the committee, and former NFRW presidents.

We support the objectives and policies of the National Federation of Republican Women (“NFRW”), the Republican National Committee (“RNC”), the Republican Party (“GOP”), and the Republican Party of Florida (“RPOF”); and I Perform any lawful activity not inconsistent with the foregoing.

Don't forget we have a couple of special elections happening in our state. Make sure your clubs are helping with those elections.
